

Do you need an authorization letter?

When managing your trust-owned rental property, you sometimes encounter parties such as utility companies, eviction companies, contractors or others who want some proof that you have the power to manage the property. You can show them the trust agreement, and as long as they don't keep a copy or record it in the public records, this is usually harmless. But some clients have asked us for an authorization letter to manage the property, so the trust does not have to be shown, or to let them think you are just the manager, not the owner. If you need one of these letters, just complete and send us the following form

The letter usually authorizes the following. You can cross out any authority you don't want in the letter:

“Legal authority to manage and control the above-referenced real property, to handle related matters including renting, turning on utilities, signing insurance applications, doing maintenance, contracting for remodeling, obtaining permits, signing notices of commencement, zoning matters, homeowner association matters, and all related matters concerning the property in this trust, other than title matters such as deeds and mortgages which are signed by the trustee.”
